

# Asperger-specific support in Leicester City

## We have a *vacancy* in our Asperger Syndrome floating support scheme

Our team of trained and experienced staff support people with Asperger Syndrome in housing related issues such as:

Maintaining their tenancy, budgeting, accessing healthcare, getting organised, socialising, and finding appropriate daily occupation

We can even provide **specialist Social Skills training** as part of this floating support, using the new NAS *SocialEyes* social skills package

This is a long-term scheme, so although people are encouraged to develop independence, there is no cut off point for doing so

Recipients of support must be resident in the city and have, or be in the process of arranging, their own tenancy (for example they may be about to move out of the family home)

The scheme is already funded by Supporting People, and after assessment people can start receiving the support immediately – **no additional funding is required**
